

ASI Survey 2012-13 Highlights

Central Statistics Office (CSO) has been conducting national level industrial survey every year. The Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) furnishes the major characteristics that reflect the industrial sector. State conducts the Survey as per the guidance of CSO and publish the report by consolidating the district level data. Annual Survey of Industries is the most important source of industrial statistics of the registered/organised manufacturing sector of the economy. It provides statistical information to assess and evaluate, objectively and realistically, the changes in the growth, composition and structure of organized manufacturing sector. It is an effective tool for planners and policy makers to assess the performance of industrial section and in framing new policies. The industrial data for the financial year 2012-13 is collected and analysed during the year 2013-14.
